Subject: Introduction of the imageRUNNER 1400 Series

Canon U.S.A., Inc. is pleased to introduce the imageRUNNER 1400 Series designed for busy workgroups that need powerful productivity in a compact size. These letter/legal size (A4) black and white models provide a compelling blend of price and performance, improvements in cost of operation, and uniFLOW support, in an MDS-ready platform.

Overview

The imageRUNNER 1400 Series will replace the imageRUNNER 1025 Series as the most compact models in Canon's imageRUNNER and imageRUNNER ADVANCE product line. The imageRUNNER 1400 Series is a strategically important product designed to meet the needs of the growing A4 and MPS market opportunity. The Series complements the existing imageRUNNER and imageRUNNER ADVANCE line by supporting the same management tools and solutions such as imageWARE Enterprise Management Console, imageWARE Remote and uniFLOW, while offering a compact solution. The imageRUNNER 1400 Series is well suited for both individual placements and fleet environments alongside other imageRUNNER and imageRUNNER ADVANCE models.

The Series consists of the following models, all of which output at up to 37 ppm (Letter, BW):

- imageRUNNER 1435iF: Copy, Send, Print (Std.: UFR II LT, PCL, Adobe PS), Fax
- imageRUNNER 1435i: Copy, Send, Print (Std.: UFR II LT)
- imageRUNNER 1435P: Print only (Std.: UFR II LT, PCL, Adobe PS)

Key Features and Benefits

The new imageRUNNER 1400 Series shares many of the features and attributes that are familiar from other imageRUNNER A4 models, namely: combining simplicity of operation and significantly improved durability with a compact design and low operating costs. A core value is a strong and highly competitive Total Cost of Ownership that is significantly improved compared to the predecessor model. The imageRUNNER 1400 Series continues Canon's "Less Maintenance" design approach to maximize both customer uptime and Dealer servicing efficiency to help increase customer satisfaction and improve Dealer profitability.

The imageRUNNER 1400 Series core marking engine is based on the historically highly reliable imageRUNNER 1025, with improvements to performance, durability, and system capabilities. The imageRUNNER 1400 Series system uses an updated version of Canon's imageCHIP Lite controller to deliver a simplified yet robust feature set, striking a balance between high functionality and low cost of acquisition. This brings a strong competitive feature set to meet more bid and RFP requirements and give easier support and consistency for fleet management and MDS engagements

MDS Enabler

With the consistency to Canon's device management platforms, these new models can be managed with the same tools as other Canon devices for customer, dealer, and MDS providers' efficiency. These models include embedded uniFLOW solution capability via firmware, activated via a Compact Device license on the uniFLOW server. Supported uniFLOW functions include authentication (including card-based authentication), cost tracking, mobile printing, and secure print release. With

their competitive TCO the imageRUNNER 1400 Series models can serve as an effective replacement for higher cost single function printers. This means these models can complement the fleet and an MDS focus, without trading off management solutions whether a need is for a single function printer or a small MFP.

Series Configuration Overview

The imageRUNNER 1400 Series is comprised of three models each outputting up to 37 ppm. The imageRUNNER 1435iF supports Copy, Fax, Send, and Print (UFR II LT, PCL, and Adobe PS) as standard. The imageRUNNER 1435i supports Copy, Send, and Print with UFR II LT standard and both PCL and Adobe PS optional; no fax option is supported. The imageRUNNER 1435P is a printer-only version with UFR II LT, PCL, and Adobe PS standard.
